Therefore, this year we will work with "Nehemiah's Vision" Disaster Relief Ministry in or near Port Bolivar, Texas (north of Galveston and east of Texas City).

We will not give the Lord an offering that did not or does not cost us something. The fee will be determined by how many go, but for example if 20-49 people go, the fee is expected to be \$89.00 per person. The fee included insurance, housing, coordination and other related expenses.

More information will be forthcoming as it is received. This is Kingdom Work and I believe God would want His people . . . His church . . . to help.
