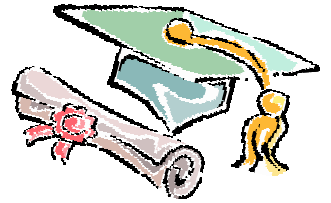

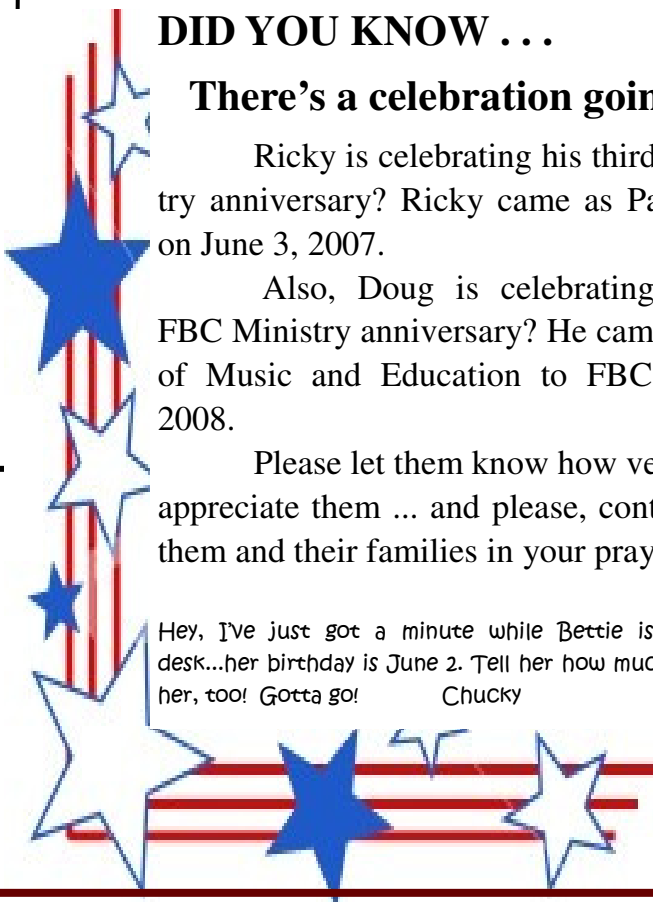
### There's a celebration going on?

I'm glad you are here today. Hey, do something good for someone this week!

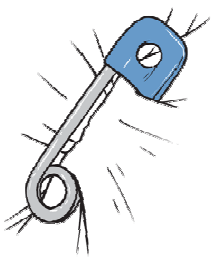
