Flexibility has been our word here at First Baptist since Thursday June 11. I remember that morning calling my dad to wish him happy birthday and then we began the day getting ready for Vacation Bible School. It had been a great week so far and we were getting excited about all the kids that would be coming that night. The evening began as each one had but we had heard about some storms that might move in; so we, as a staff, began to make all the emergency preparations to be ready just in case.

And then it happened. About 7:25 p.m. someone said that we have severe storms and they would hit us in about 30 minutes. Well I don't know whose watch they were going by but it wasn't more than 10 minutes later and everything began to blow away. Literally the roof on all three of the buildings began to fly off. We stood in the foyers of each building watching tin fly away. That is an incredible site to see. I tell you this just to let you know how excited I am to say that we serve a "Big God!" Through it all He kept each of us safe. Over 100 people and no one were injured.

Well by now everything has settled down, and we

are now waiting to hear the final judgment from our insurance company. I am confident that it will be a great word from them. Please keep us in prayer as we work through this, but I want to encourage us to keep our eyes on Jesus as we meet in a different place during the next month for worship. We have to be thankful that we have an alternative space to meet and that we are not under the trees in the heat. God is a great God and He has provided for us.

We did have lots of damage, but as Russell Garner introduced Sunday morning, we now have several projects to work on and I hope there will be some groups, Sunday school classes, individuals who will step up and take on one of the adopt a program projects. If you need to know what projects, just call the office or contact Russell. The auditorium has been taken care of by the insurance company as we will begin to see some updating as we work to attract younger families to worship with us.

We talk about loving each other and loving our church. We talk about how we need to step up when God puts something

in front of us, and I believe that He has put a tremendous step in front of us. Now it is up to each of us to accept the challenge before us. Many of these projects will cost some money and we need to get involved where we feel God leading us.

In the midst of all that has happened, we are seeing some exciting things happen at First Baptist Church. You need to be here to see what is going on and to get involved. If you are not here, then you are missing out on all the blessings that God has given to us. I hope that you will come and see. If you have not been in a while, I challenge you to come see, and you will not be disappointed. Join us this Sunday as we worship together. I look forward to seeing each of you here. I know I tell you this all the time, but I really do mean it when I say that . . . I love being your Pastor!

Why consider E-Giving?

Make the first money you spend each month your gift to God. In today's fast paced economy many monthly payments are automatically deducted from your bank accounts leaving your tithe as the last money you spend each month.

Honor your pledge by making your tithe automatically deducted thus avoiding missed giving when on vacation or out of town.

It is convenient and saves time and money. There are no checks to write and saves First Baptist Church monthly processing charges.

There are several choices for E-Giving:

Gifts can be given by using your checking account, savings account, or debit

Credit & Debit Card gifts can be done immediately by simply signing up as a user.

Checking / Savings accounts need to complete a Direct Debit Authorization Form, then sign up as a user.

There are several types of transactions you can use:

Recurring Automatic Deduction allows you to have a preset amount transferred from your checking or savings account or charged using your debit or credit card. These funds would be sent to First Baptist Church on a regular calendar basis, such as weekly, monthly or as you designate.

One Time Donations allows you to direct each transfer individually.

You may also combine these ways of giving and types of transactions.

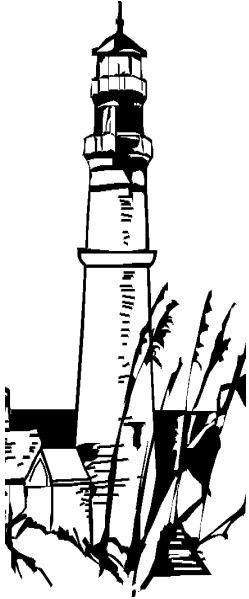
